RESOLUTION NO. 871-2025
Adopting the 2024 Eastern Montana Region Hazard Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre and post disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus resides within the Planning Area, and fully participated in the mitigation planning process to prepare this Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UESOLVED, the City of Columbus hereby adopts the Eastern Montana Region Hazard Mitigation Plan, as its official plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Columbus hereby adopts Addendum U City of Columbus Hazard Mitigation Plan to include the modifications presented by the mayor; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; to maintain a detailed county specific hazard mitigation plan, the City of Columbus hereby adopts the current 2021 Stillwater County Hazard Mitigation Plan as an appendix to the 2024 Eastern Montana Region Mitigation Plan.


