

## Stillwater County Solid Waste Accepted Items & Fee Schedule



### **No Fee:**

Household Garbage

Branches, Limbs – must be cut to 4 foot or smaller

### **We Recycle:**

Metal – All Sites

Aluminum Cans – Columbus, Absarokee, Molt, Nye, Reed Point

Oil – No more than 10 gallons at a time – Columbus, Park City, Reed Point, Nye

**Refrigerated appliances and air conditioners must be certified refrigerant free and the compressor removed before the item will be accepted.**

Local businesses that recover Freon and remove compressors are: RN Appliance, Laurel 628-7411; Two Rivers Heating and Air Conditioning, Columbus 406-544-4015; and Gary Lofing, Columbus 322-5574.

**Construction Debris, Trees and Branches must be cut to 4 foot lengths or smaller.**

### **Fees Collected:**

Pallets - \$2.00 each or \$12.00 per cubic yard (6 pallets = 1 cubic yard)

Construction Debris - \$17.00 per cubic yard

Roofing Debris - \$17.00 per cubic yard

Carpet - \$10.00 per cubic yard

Couches - \$15.00 each

Loveseats - \$10.00 each

Living Room Chairs (Recliners, accent chairs, etc.) - \$5.00 each

Mattresses (all sizes) - \$10.00 each

Box Springs (all sizes) - \$10.00 each

Passenger & Light Truck Tires, ATV, etc. - \$5.00 each

Passenger & Light Truck Tires, ATV, etc. w/rim - \$10.00 each

Semi Tire - \$10.00 each

Semi Tire w/rim - \$15.00 each

Tractor/Equipment Tires - \$36.00 each

Cut up Tires - \$5.00 per cubic yard (4 Tires = 1 cubic yard)

Barrels not cleaned - \$10.00 each

Animal Carcass – sheep, calf, goat - \$24.00 each

Agriculture Waste - \$17.00 per cubic yard (including but not limited to: manure, hay, straw, bedding, etc.)

Commercially Generated Yard Debris, Tree/Brush Trimmings - \$10.00 per cubic yard

Used Oil - \$0.50 per gallon

Out of District Permit - \$255.30 per year

**Out of District Permits must be purchased before dumping. This includes all out of county residents as well as residents within the city limits of the Town of Columbus.**

**Construction Debris in quantities larger than 10 cubic yards should be hauled in roll-off boxes available for rent.**
