ADOPTION OF SCHEDULE FOR
ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
SEPTIC SYSTEM PERMITTING FEES

WHEREAS, pursuant to 7-6-4013, MCA, the Stillwater County Board of Health is authorized to establish fees for environmental health services, and

WHEREAS, the Stillwater County Board of Health deems it to be in the best interest of the inhabitants of Stillwater County served by the Department to establish fees for environmental health services; and

WHEREAS, the Stillwater County Board of Health has determined, and has taken such action and made such investigations as are necessary, in its judgment, to support its determination that the proposed fees for environmental health services are fair and reasonable; see attached "Exhibit A"

WHEREAS, a duly advertised public hearing for the Septic System Permitting Fees was held on October 2, 2018, and the Commission invited comments on the proposed fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that after giving due consideration to the results of the hearing, the Commission hereby approved the fees as shown in Exhibit A (see attached).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Stillwater County Board of County Commissioners hereby adopt the attached revised Environmental Health Proposed Schedule of Fees, to become effective at the date of signing this resolution.


