To Individuals requesting information on the Stillwater River Road Rockslide:

The County Commissioners have received the latest report from GeoStabilization International (GSI). Please see attached report in PDF format. You will notice that the cost estimate has been redacted out. This was done at GSI's request for proprietary reasons only. The cost of the project has doubled in this report from the costs reviewed in the first GSI report dated July 13th the public previously received at the Nye public meeting.

The County has submitted a grant application to FEMA for review. There are three levels of review that this application needs to go through. The first level of review should be completed in 90 days.

The County purchased and placed signs indicating a road closure ahead. The signs were placed on both ends of the closure. The signs placed on the Absarokee side were recently stolen. The County asks that if anyone has any information regarding the stolen signs, please contact the Stillwater County Sheriff's Office.
