INVITATION TO BID
GRAVEL CRUSHING

Sealed bids for 35,000 cubic yards of crushed gravel will be received in the Stillwater County Human Resources and Finance Department at the Stillwater County Courthouse, PO Box 795, Columbus MT, 59019, until 5:00 P.M. on Monday October 3, 2016. Bids will be opened and read aloud at 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday October 4, 2016 in the County Commissioner's meeting room on the first floor of the County, at 400 3rd Avenue North, Columbus, MT. Envelopes containing bids will be marked "Gravel Crushing Bid".

The gravel will be excavated, crushed and stockpiled at the following two (2) locations:

****These Pits are shale rock pits on a sandstone ridge.****

Marsh Pit – located on Gee Road South East of Rapelje, MT situated in Section 29, Township 2N, Range 21 East, MPM. 10,000 cubic yards.

Karls Pit- located on Molt Rapelje Road situated in Section 20, Township 2 North, Range 22 East, MPM. 25,000 cubic yards.

The crushed gravel will be specified to size 1½” percent passing 100%, size 1”-percent passing 85%, size ¾” percent passing 70/80%, size 3/8” percent passing 50/60%, size No. 40 percent passing 20/30%, size No. 200 8 ½% passing. Bids must indicate the unit price per cubic yard and total bid for each location. Bids must be signed, contain the contractor's license number and corporate seal, if applicable.

Questions can be answered by the Superintendent of Roads/Bridges for Stillwater County by calling 406-322-5336, between 7:00 A.M. and 5:30 P.M., Monday through Thursday.

Bids shall be accompanied by a bid security bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid. Said security bond shall be in the form of a money order, cashier's check, certified check or bank draft. The successful bidder shall furnish an approved performance bond and payment bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract.

Successful bidder will be subject to prevailing wage rates under the Davis/Bacon Act of 1931.

Each bidder will be required to have a Montana Public Contractor's License. No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled time for public opening of bids. The County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids received, to waive bid irregularities, to postpone the award of a contract for a period not exceeding sixty (60) days and to accept the bid which is in the best interest of Stillwater County.
