Introductions

DES: Chris Rasmussen discussed the study being done by CDM Engineering concerning the I-90 closures. They are looking at the best options on where to close the interstate and park vehicles in the event of fires, winter storms, etc. The study began about 4 months ago and is scheduled for about a year.

Tom Frieders was notified by Pronovost of the flood change vote taken during the October LEPC meeting.

- E-911: Siegfried reported that Emergency Medical Dispatch is now being used by the dispatch center. One dispatcher is currently in EMD training and when she finishes, all dispatchers will be certified in EMD.
- LEPC: Sheriff Brophy announced that due to a lack of participants there will be no by-laws sub-committee meeting today.
- PHEP: Sailer advised that there is a strain of stomach flu going around and said that if you get this flu you should not return to work for 24-48 hours after your last vomiting/diarrhea to prevent spreading the virus.
- Chem-Pak is available for Stillwater County out of Billings. Chem-Pak is used in the event of large-scale breakout of anthrax etc. If needed, the Little Metra will be used for vaccinations.

- Communication: Pronovost updated the group on the 911 equipment service contract. It was decided to not have a contract at this time and the issue will be re-visited in May, 2019 to ascertain if we need a contract.
- I Am Responding will now be available to 6 agencies in Stillwater County and will be paid for out of fire funds, this includes Molt and Rapelje Fire Departments. SAR has a current contract for at least 2 more years and will not be part of this cycle.
