Position Title: Weed District Coordinator

Function: This position is responsible for the weed programs in Stillwater County. The function of this program is to provide education, organizational skills, prepare contracts, negotiate with contractors, the public and private agencies as well as assist in research on specific problems in the county, and mapping of weed areas using GPS/GIS applications.

Required: A Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture or natural resource related field or 4 or more years' experience in a related academic field. Supervisory experience or skills requiring attention to detail and safety. Must be able to identify weeds found in Stillwater County. Work is performed indoors and out and, during the growing season especially, incumbent will be expected to work early hours, late hours and occasionally on weekends, if needed. Must be able to operate cars, pickups, 4-wheelers, GPS units, spray equipment, and other equipment as well as travel to various locations for work or meetings.

Special Requirements: Must have or be able to obtain within 6 months, a Government Applicator's License and a Pesticide Dealer's License for purchasing and distributing chemicals. Must have or be able to obtain within 6 months, a Weed-Free Seed, Hay and Forage Inspector's License

Desired: Course work in Agronomy, Weed Science, Plant and Soil Science, Plant Pathology and Entomology. Working knowledge of GPS and able to use ArcView, CountyCad, spreadsheets, and other computer programs as necessary.
